Extended Liquor Sales Hours for the Holidays

The Westfield Town Council recently passed an ordinance allowing liquor sales starting at 9am on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve. (Typically, liquor sales are not allowed until noon on Sundays). Thank you Mayor & Council!

Pay for Parking at Street Meters by Mobile App!

The town has completed the installation of new, solar "smart" parking meters in the Downtown area that are user friendly and offer an abundance of convenient payment options. In addition to the traditional forms of payment - Westfield tokens, coins (quarters, dimes, and nickels), and Smart Card - you can now pay with a credit card (Visa, Master Card and Discover) or a debit card (minimum of \$1.00 for credit/debit) and by mobile app!

Using the pay-by-app option, no one ever need worry about whether they put enough money in the meter because, for example, their haircut appointment is running late or they ran into a friend and were having an extended conversation. You now have the ability to remotely add time to the meter (up to the space's time limit) from your mobile device. [Read more,,,,](#)
