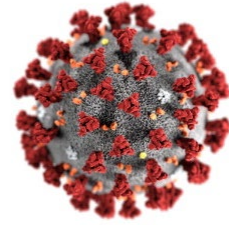




## Mayor Brindle's COVID-19 Update October 9, 2020



### **CONFIRMED CASES**

Today, there are 212,013 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in New Jersey to date, with another 363 still under investigation. Union County has reported 18,109 cases in total, with Westfield reporting four new cases since my last update on Tuesday (one on Wednesday and three on Thursday) -- bringing our total to 401 since our first reported case in March.

As previously announced, I will be using Friday updates strictly for the purposes of reporting weekly data from the Department of Health, with my more expansive updates to continue every Tuesday going forward.

From October 2-8, there were nine cases of COVID-19 reported in Westfield in our official case count. The Health Department has data on four of those nine cases, which follows below.

The ages of the four cases were 21, 23, 49, and 62. Of these cases:

- One case lives at college (out of state)
- One case has no known exposure
- Two cases live together (household contacts)

We do continue to see an uptick in cases both regionally and statewide. That said, please continue to stay diligent with COVID-19 precautions, and enjoy your weekend.
